### **General Conditions** and Restrictions

Couple

The couple rate is reserved for individuals in a committed relationship and living together. Proof of shared residence will be required.

Date of birth

All Junior, Intermediate and Senior members must provide an identification document with their picture and their date of birth.

Junior

Juniors between the ages of 7 and 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times, on course.

Electric cart

A driver's license is mandatory to drive or rent an electric cart.

Guest

A guest can only be invited a maximum of five times per season on the course.

- Reservation Rules
  - Arrive at the tee at least ten (10) minutes before the scheduled time.
  - Reserve only one tee time per day per person. Additional tee times, such as "replays" and "action nines," may only be made with the Club's approbation and are subject to availability.

Register the names of all players in the group within forty-eight (48) hours of the tee time. After this period, anonymous reservations will be canceled without notice.

- Speed Of Play
  - You must maintain pace with the group ahead of you.
  - Follow golfer's etiquette to let faster players pass if possible.
- Tee Time Cancellation Policy

Any cancellation or modification of a tee-time reservation must be made at least 24 hours in advance. In the event of a no-show, the Club reserves the right to charge a fee of \$200 to the person who made the reservation.

Bag Storage

Each bag stored must not exceed 16 kg (35 lb), and any wet towels must be removed prior to storage. Bags must be collected no later than October 31. Any items left after this date may be removed by staff without notice. The Club assumes no responsibility in the event of loss, theft, fire, vandalism, or any other damage.

Locker Rooms

Lockers must be completely emptied no later than October 31. Any items left after this date may be removed by staff without notice. The Club assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, fire, vandalism, or any other damage to personal belongings left in lockers.





### **General Conditions** and Restrictions

#### Game Ethics:

Conduct

Members must always demonstrate respect, courtesy, and safe conduct throughout all Club facilities.

#### Responsibility

Each golfer is responsible for any physical, moral, or material damage caused by their actions, their ball, clubs, trolley, or the golf cart they are using.

#### Alcohol

Bringing alcoholic beverages from outside the Club is **strictly prohibited**. As our liquor license extends to the entire course, management reserves the right to inspect the contents of bags or coolers.

#### Guests

Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests.

#### • Sanctions and Termination

In the event of non-compliance with rules, terms, or conditions, management reserves the right to apply sanctions, which may include suspension of playing privileges or termination of membership, without compensation.

#### Membership

An amount of \$500 will be retained to cover any expenses that may have been incurred by the Club for any refund to a member who withdraws their privileges before February 15, 2026.

No refunds will be issued after this date.

### **Golf Dress Code**

General rules

Golfers must wear appropriate clothing and shoes for playing golf. Management reserves the right to deny access to anyone wearing attire deemed inappropriate. Wearing jeans or any denim clothing, regardless of color, is prohibited on the course and practice areas. T-shirts are not allowed on the course or practice areas. Safari pants, jogging pants, and cargo pants are not permitted on the course or practice areas.

Dress code for Women

Shirts, with or without a collar, may be worn with or without sleeves; however, shoulders must remain covered. Spaghetti strap tops, and those with a low neckline or an open back are prohibited on the course and practice areas.

Dress code for Men

Only golf polos or vests with a collar, as well as turtleneck or mock-neck sweaters, are permitted and must be tucked into pants or Bermuda shorts. Capri pants and cargo-style Bermuda shorts are prohibited on the course and practice areas. Wearing a cap with the visor facing backward is not allowed.
